Bringing heavy, polluting plant through this Close is an accident waiting to happen. In addition this road is not adopted by the Council so any damage caused by heavy vehicles may be the responsibility of the residents. I understand the need for more housing, especially affordable housing, but the access to PP43 should only be via Armoury Road, close to Bradbook Cottages. I realise this might mean a few old trees may need to be removed, which is sad, but it would be preferable to a fatal accident in our Close. The houses in Armoury Road are set much further back than is possible in our Close, which would allow better access for heavy plant vehicles. I hope this helps the Planning Process.
